The College is planning to reintroduce Activities Week for students in years 7, 8 and 9 for 2024. It will take place between Monday 15th July and Friday 19th July.

Students in Years 8 & 9 will take part in a range of educational and extracurricular opportunities that go beyond the regular curriculum. These activities, including trips, workshops and specialised lessons, are designed to build on students' learning in the classroom as well as introduce them to new skills and experiences.

Students will need to opt for up to five activities, one for each day of the week. Some of the activities last longer than one day, so if choosing the longer ones, please double check how long it lasts and choose a combination of activities which fills the week.

The cost and signing up

The cost of the activities varies depending on the nature of the trip or event. The costs cover transportation, materials, and expert instructors. We are committed to providing the best possible education, and we have planned a range of activities to cover a range of interests and costs. Where possible the costs can be covered in instalments as outlined on Parent Pay.

If you have any further questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to reach out to us. We appreciate your understanding and support in ensuring a fantastic Activities Week for your child.

Parents / carers can cover the cost through Parent Pay and also indicate which of the onsite activities your son or daughter would like to participate in. Some activities may have a maximum group size. Places will be allocated on a first come first served basis when the bookings open on Parent Pay, which will open on Monday 4th December for Year 9 and Monday 11th December for Year 8.

Parent Pay

All parents should have access to a Parent Pay account already, however, some may need to activate their account by using the details in the email from Parent Pay which was sent at the start of September.
